Apple Pickin' Tour



Take a wagon ride through the orchard and pick your very own apple!

Learn about apples starting from the tree. Students can see the difference between a traditional apple tree and the newer developed high-density apple tree. See the apple move from the tree to storage, through the sorting machines, and finally to the fall treats you enjoy. Students will get to walk through the enormous coolers where all the apples are stored as well as see the process of how we make our delicious apple cider. Finally, students will even get to see how our bakery takes whole apples and turns them into delicious fall treats.

Tour will take approximately 45 minutes to 1 hour.
