Pumpkin Patch Tour



Take a wagon ride through the orchard and pick your very own pumpkin!

As students ride through the orchard on the way to the pumpkin patch they will learn about bees, pollination, and how useful bees are to an orchard. Students will get to see the hives of bees the orchard uses to pollinate the trees.

Once at the pumpkin patch children will see the growth stages of a pumpkin and eventually pick their very own pumpkin to take home.

This tour takes approximately 30 to 45 minutes.

Did you
know?

The Community Orchard plants more than 15 varieties of pumpkins, gourds, and squash to be harvested each year.
